# INCREASING CHALLENGES, GREATER OPPORTUNITIES

NICOLÁS IBAÑEZ SCOTT PRESIDENT OF THE FPP BOARD

#### EAR FPP BENEFACTORS AND FRIENDS:

On behalf of the Board, I am glad to present the work we have done during 2015. But first I would like to briefly review the context of Chile and the world.

The year 2015 will probably be remembered through history as a year of crucial events for Latin America. First, the change of government in Argentina marked an important and promising milestone. After years of Peronism, a door of political, economic and social opportunities has been opened and the current government of Mauricio Macri should take advantage of it. Meanwhile, in Venezuela, the foundations of the Bolivarian electoral autocracy have been shaken by the opposition's triumph over 21st Century Socialism in the country's National Assembly. There is also evidence suggesting new political map movements, especially in countries like Brazil and in those where the aforementioned events may have some effect. However. the advance of populism and radical ideas taking power, specifically in Spain, are concerning at an Ibero-American level.

Over the past year, the climate in Chile has substantially changed. The uncertainty and its

consequences are already evident in the economy and the social environment, all because of the proposed course and the unsteady yet clear government steps taken during the institutional transformation of the country. Advancing reforms regarding educational, labor, tax, and constitutional areas as well as the increasing tension and polarization have further injured the pax chilensis, this virtuous period of good sense, social peace, and progress that ruled since the return of democracy up until about four years ago. In 2011, we saw for the first time in a long while a state of physical and verbal violence we had thought gone long ago.

There are some disturbing symptoms that I have to add that we are all responsible for in one way or another: the weakening of trusts, more insecurity and violence –particularly frailty of the Rule of Law in regions such as La Araucanía, lack of integrity among politicians and businessmen, populist temptations, claims of ideological imposition, neglect of the quality of public policies, and the breakdown of basic agreements typical of a free society, among others. These circumstances are certainly negative, and the challenges are increasing, but, at the same time, they offer an opportunity to rectify and to mature. Additionally, the national current situation gives us the

possibility to propose our ideas and opinions in public debate.

We, as FPP, are working in this field by helping to protect and strengthen the cultural and institutional foundations of our society. History shows that you can unexpectedly lose your way, and that it is possible to inflict damage that is difficult to repair. Thus, our work has focused on understanding what is happening and collaborating, from our responsibility as citizens and civil society, with the integrity of our institutions and civic friendship.

We have had very significant milestones, such as visits by prestigious international speakers, national tours to promote two influential books written by our Executive Director and our Senior Fellows - La Tiranía de la Igualdad by Axel Kaiser, and Diálogo de Conversos by Mauricio Rojas and Roberto Ampuero – and the opening of our first regional office in the historic port of Valparaíso. We also launched the Barómetro de la Libertad (Barometer of Liberty) and published numerous essays, opinion pieces and letters. Additionally, our participation in audiovisual media has reached a new record with very good results and our sustained regional presence has exponentially increased by carrying out promotional and educational activities throughout the country. In this second line of work, about 7,000 people were involved in 2015, mostly young people. All this has allowed us to communicate with our audience and hear their experiences, perspectives and concerns.

Regarding organization, the FPP has advanced both quantitatively and qualitatively, particu-

larly in terms of skills and expertise. We have given priority to professionalization as the key for the challenges we face and the objectives we seek to meet.

I would like to emphasize that our work and plans are long-term projections and are part of a joint effort that we have undertaken, along with the help of partner organizations, at various levels and places: universities, research centers, the media, and citizen activism, among others. We are motivated by our ideals: liberal democracy, the Rule of Law, a vigorous market economy, a modern and efficient State focused on serving people, and a powerful civil society.

I wish to thank, in this intellectual and social venture, the support from other research centers, both Chilean and foreign, the goodness of our benefactors, the openness of the media, the work of young volunteers and the passionate dedication of our collaborators as well as our partners and suppliers.

In closing, I would like to invite you to join this exciting initiative, to do more and worry less, and to join us from now on this path towards a more respectable, prosperous, peaceful, and freer Chile.

2015. Through its dozens events, hundreds of media appearances, publications and educational activities, the cause that the institution carries out has reached a new level of impact. The ideal of a more respectable, prosperous, peaceful,

and freer Chile, based on the principles of classical liberalism, is increasingly known and increasingly alive in the public debate.

Today, the FPP, with 10 speakers, reaches an diverse audience and has a significant level of media exposure. Also, its presence in academic and cultural environments has expanded as never before. An example that clearly illustrates this is that two books written by members of our team, who spread the ideals of freedom, have managed to be among the 10 best selling books in Chile, and for several months. This impact is unprecedented in recent decades among other think tanks, and it was precisely this fact, along with the opening of our regional office, which for the first time took us all over the country.

In the second half of 2015, the FPP covered 13 cities in 9 regions, from Arica in the north to Punta Arenas in the far south. This resulted in regional media appearances, university conferences and

meetings with local leaders, young people and businessmen, among other activities.

Through our tour we came into contact with the different realities and perspectives of each place we visited. This allowed us to discuss, debate and, above all, listen, which is something that is very important for our work and will enable us to truly contribute to the country.

FPP has taken on the key challenge of expanding and mantaining its work with regions. It is very important to progress in the descentralization of power and to make more visible the major problems of people who live and work in the different regions of our country.

In short, to FPP, and notwithstanding all that remains to be improved, 2015 has been a year of progress regarding organizational aspects and the realization of our regional vocation, which is indispensable in today's Chile.

FPP honors the French economist Jean Gustave Courcelle-Seneuil for contributing in such a valuable way to the dissemination and promotion of economy and classical liberal ideology in Chile. Courcelle-Seneuil was hired by the Chilean government with the mission of establishing and developing the discipline of political economy in the nascent Republic of Chile. He carried out his work between 1855 and 1863, as a professor at the National Institute and at the University of Chile, and as an advisor to the Ministry of Finance. —

#### What is classical liberalism?

The concept of classical liberalism includes a set of political ideas developed in Europe in the 17th and 18th centuries. This ideology advocates limits on the State's absolute power and its intervention in civil affairs and the eradication of political and social privileges. The purpose is to allow people to fully develop their abilities and projects in a free environment.



## **I RESEARCH**

FPP, CONSISTENT WITH ITS ACADEMIC AND ANALYTICAL VOCATION, IS CONTINUALLY CONDUCTING STUDIES OF GENERAL PUBLIC INTEREST. IN 2015, TWO VERY IMPORTANT WORKS WERE PUBLISHED:

#### BARÓMETRO DE LA LIBERTAD (BAROMETER OF LIBERTY)

Designed by the prestigious company GfK-Adimark, this project seeks to be a contribution to the knowledge of Chilean political culture, especially regarding the understanding on how important freedom is in our lives and the value of the ideas of a free society. This study had 22 press appearances, was on the front page of a nation-wide newspaper, and elicited discussions in audiovisual media.

### CONCIENCIA FISCAL [TAX AWARENESS]

Fifty-five percent of Chileans believe that they pay little or no taxes. That is, more than half of the population has no idea of the impact that taxes have on their lives and income. The *Tax Awareness* project seeks to change this by informing citizens about the taxes they pay and encouraging them to be more demanding with how the government uses these resources.

#### ESSAYS

#### OFICIOS PORTEÑOS (PROFESSIONS OF THE PORT OF VALPARAÍSOI

This exhibition, organized by FPP Valparaiso in collaboration with the photographer Pablo Izquierdo, was presented on September 22<sup>nd</sup> with the purpose of recognizing the value of work as a fundamental part of progress. The work of the renowned American author Deirdre McCloskey served as an inspiration for these photographs. Her book Bourgeois dignity explains the vital importance of the virtues of work: integrity, honesty, reliability, entrepreneurship, sense of humor, respect, modesty, thoughtfulness, responsibility, prudence, and austerity. This exhibition tells, through pictures, of the lives of people of Valparaiso -artists, businessmen, traders, athletes, etc. - whose activities have contributed to the economic development of the historic port.

The exhibition is itinerant since it was presented in the famous Eduardo de la Barra High School and the Adventist School of La Calera, among other educational institutions.

#### WORKSHOPS

They are designed to develop skills, analytical ability and critical thinking. In October, John Müller taught the Workshop Communicating Ideas. It was developed in six theoretical and practical sessions with the participation of 16 FPP alumni. John Müller is a recognized and experienced Chilean journalist based in Spain and former deputy editor of the newspaper *El Mundo*.

#### COURSES FOR POLITICAL DEBATE

Due to popular demand, courses specially designed for youth were taught. These individuals were members of student associations and young people belonging to parties and other organizations who have supported free society ideology and who also see themselves as student or political leaders, and in the future as representatives of people in some key positions. Two courses of this kind were offered:

- PRINCIPLES OF A FREE SOCIETY FOR UNI-VERSITY ACTION, FROM APRIL 10<sup>TH</sup> TO MAY 8<sup>TH</sup>. 2015.
- LIBERAL ARGUMENTS FOR POLITICAL DEBATE, ON JUNE 5<sup>TH</sup> AND 6<sup>TH</sup>, 2015.

#### LIBERAL ACADEMY

This is an online course aimed primarily at young people between 18 and 30 years of age who live in any region of Chile or abroad, and who are unable to personally participate at the educational activities offered by the FPP. The program is organized into four sections: principles of a free society, liberal ethics, institutions of a liberal democracy, and progress and freedom. The methodology is professionally designed in order to be learned through a digital platform with high technological capabilities that combine written and multimedia content. This project is carried out in association with eClass.



### FOURTH VERSION EL CATO - FPP UNIVERSITY

It is an annual event organized together with the American think tank Cato Institute, based in Washington D.C. It brings together 70 young people –50 from Chile and 20 from various countries of Latin America – who participate in conferences during four days.

The purpose of the alliance UCatoFPP, which in 2015 took place in the region of Libertador Bernardo O'Higgins, Chile, is to give participants the opportunity to learn about and discuss the foundations, trends, and essential ideas of a free society as well as the main problems and prospects of Chile and Latin America. It is also a unique opportunity for students to truly get to know the most prestigious international intellectuals and academics, so they can freely ask questions and express their concerns.







# SESSIONS AND TUTORIALS

### ROSTROS DE LA LIBERTAD (FACES OF FREEDOM)

These sessions took place in Santiago and Valparaíso where the biographies; intellectual and cultural contributions of 11 important characters, were presented. These were Hannah Arendt, Frank Zappa, Oscar Wilde, George Orwell, Henry Hazlitt, Mario Vargas Llosa, Clint Eastwood, José Victorino Lastarria, Deirdre McCloskey, Ayaan Hirsi Ali and Václav Havel.

### TALKS ON INTERNATIONAL CURRENT AFFAIRS

Held between May and June together with the educational initiative *Red Cultural*, these sessions were useful to analyze and explain current situations of major importance, such as complications in the Middle East with the Islamic state and the Arab-Israeli conflict, Russia on the international scene, Iran and the nuclear issue, among others.

#### **BOOK CLUBS**

They are consecutive sessions of in-depth discussion on outstanding books that are currently in the intellectual debate. They are specially organized for FPP Alumni as part of their continuous education and end with a conversation with the author.

#### **TUTORIALS**

The tutorials are conducted in small groups by a FPP researcher. The purpose of this activity is to give guidelines to the students in meetings that allow them to reflect and discuss. The 2015 tutorials were conducted between September and December in Santiago and Valparaiso.

# TALKS AND CONFERENCES

#### GRAMSCI'S POLITICAL THOUGHT

FPP has emphasized the ideas of authors and intellectuals who have favored culture in politics. Antonio Gramsci is one of the most influential people in this regard, whose thinking has served as a political guideline for movements, parties, and governments contrary to the ideas of a free society, many of them with totalitarian and hegemonic purposes. Roberto Ampuero was in charge of explaining the phenomenon and the presence of Gramsci's thought in current Chilean politics.



#### POPULISM IN LATIN AMERICA: THREE PERSPECTIVES

This activity took place on April 9th as a prelude to the visit of Gloria Álvarez to Chile. The purpose of the conference was to share the experiences of two young people from Argentina and Venezuela, two countries hit by populism. The speakers were María José Romano and Eugenio Guerrero.

#### ACTIVE AND DETERMINED: WOMEN IN CONTEMPORARY SOCIETY

FPP celebrates Women's History Month with a talk on the role of women in society. The speakers on this occasion were the former Minister of Education and also former Minister of the National Women's Service, Carolina Schmidt, and the senior economist from the Chilean think tank Libertad y Desarrollo, Cecilia Cifuentes. The dean of the Journalism School at Adolfo Ibáñez University, Marily Luders, was the moderator.

#### OVERCOMING POVERTY: A NEW WAY TO MEASURE POVERTY

Rodrigo Jordán, vice president of the Foundation for Overcoming Poverty, talked about the achievements and pending tasks of Chile in this area. He was the first South American to reach the summit of Everest in 1992 and today is known nationally and internationally for his work on issues related to innovation, leadership and social development.

This discussion takes place in meetings involving businessmen, executives, intellectuals, and analysts who talk about national and international contingency. In August and September the following issues were addressed:





The diplomatic delegation was headed by the Ambassador, Josef Rychtar, Consul General Adam Piňos, and the Commercial and Ecconomical Secretary Ondřej Kašina.



# JOINT **ACTIVITIES**

FPP WORKS TOGETHER WITH OTHER INSTITUTIONS BY CREATING COOPERATIVE ALLIANCES. IN 2015 THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES WERE ORGANIZED IN ASSOCIATION WITH SOME OF THEM:

#### FIIS: WHEN DOES CREATIVITY FLOW?

The aim of this workshop, as part of the International Festival of Social Innovation, held on October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2015, was to promote opportunities and power that entrepreneurship and creativity may generate. However, obstacles undermining innovation and production possibilities were also addressed.

#### DEBATE: MUST CHILE HAVE MARRIAGE EQUALITY?

Same-sex marriage is currently present in the political debate in Chile. On June 16th, this topic was laid on the table by FPP in association with the organization Alternativa Libertad, a student association from Universidad de los Andes.

#### NATIONAL BUSINESS ENGINEERING CONFERENCES (JONIC)

FPP acted as a collaborator and was present with an information stand in this event held on September 5<sup>th</sup> in Marbella, Region of Valparaíso. In this meeting the 200 best Chilean business engineering students were invited, and Axel Kaiser participated as speaker.

#### UNION LEADERS NATIONAL MEETING (ENALIG)

This activity was organized by the Multigremial de Emprendedores de Chile. This meeting was held on November 27th and highly recognized speakers such as Jaime Bellolio, Daniel Farcas, Alberto Espina, Darío Paya, Ramiro Mendoza, Óscar Guillermo Garretón, Sergio Pérez, Axel Kaiser and Aliro Caimapo, among others were involved.

#### THINKING FREEDOM ESSAY CONTEST 2015

FPP and the think tank Libertad y Desarrollo are in charge of this annual contest organized with the purpose of promoting discussion and dissemination of the principles and ideas favoring a free and open society. Participants, who are classified according to their ages, write a thorough review about quotes of the economist and Nobel laureate Milton Friedman and the philosopher Karl Popper.

#### PROFESSIONALIZATION AND **CONTINUOUS EDUCATION**





Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of used accounting policies and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as assessing the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.
